Proclamation Right to Know Week

WHEREAS the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act gives Nova Scotians a right of access to information in the custody or under the control of public bodies; and

WHEREAS access to information ensures citizens of Nova Scotia have the opportunity for meaningful participation in the democratic process; and

WHEREAS a celebration of the right of Nova Scotians to access information will facilitate informed public participation in policy formulation, ensure fairness in government decision-making and permit the airing and reconciliation of divergent views; and

WHEREAS Nova Scotia joins all other Canadian jurisdictions and democracies world-wide in acknowledging Right to Know Week;

THEREFORE I, Darrell E. Dexter, Premier of Nova Scotia, do hereby proclaim September 24th to 28th, 2012 to be "Right to Know Week" in the Province of Nova Scotia.
