Information and Privacy Commissioner for Nova Scotia to release investigation report concerning the MOVEit file transfer system privacy breach

HALIFAX – On Wednesday, February 19 at 10:00 a.m., Information and Privacy Commissioner for Nova Scotia Tricia Ralph will release her investigation report into the MOVEit file transfer system privacy breach caused by a cyberattack.

As a result of this privacy breach, the Nova Scotia Government sent out approximately 168,000 privacy breach notification letters to individuals identified as victims of this breach. The Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner received 110 complaints from affected individuals. In light of this, the Commissioner launched an investigation into this matter.
