N.S. Information and Privacy Commissioner to release investigation report about video surveillance in Nova Scotia schools

HALIFAX – On Thursday, October 12, at 10:00 a.m., Information and Privacy Commissioner for Nova Scotia Catherine Tully will release an investigation report concerning the disclosure of video surveillance footage from a Cape Breton school.

The Commissioner launched an investigation after learning that images from the video surveillance cameras at the Rankin School of the Narrows in Iona, Nova Scotia were publicly available through a Russian website.
