N.S. Information and Privacy Commissioner to release investigation report about disclosure of former cabinet minister's personal information

HALIFAX—On Thursday February 11, at 10:00 a.m., Information and Privacy Commissioner for Nova Scotia Catherine Tully will release an investigation report about the disclosure of a former cabinet minister's personal information by staff in the Office of the Premier.

The commissioner launched an investigation on November 25, 2015 after several media outlets reported Mr. Kirby McVicar, then Chief of Staff to the Premier, disclosing details of former cabinet minister Andrew Younger's health.
