Proclamation Right to Know Week

WHEREAS *the government of Nova Scotia has adopted the principles of openness, transparency and accountability; and*

WHEREAS *the "Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act" and Part XX of the "Municipal Government Act" give Nova Scotians a right of access to information in the custody or under the control of public bodies; and*

WHEREAS *access to information ensures citizens of Nova Scotia have the opportunity for meaningful participation in the democratic process; and*

WHEREAS *a celebration of the right of Nova Scotians to access information will facilitate informed public participation in policy formulation, ensure fairness in government decision-making and permit the airing and reconciliation of divergent views; and*

WHEREAS *Nova Scotia joins all other Canadian jurisdictions in acknowledging Right to Know Week;*

THEREFORE *be it resolved that I, Darrell E. Dexter, Premier of Nova Scotia, do hereby proclaim September 27th - October 1st, 2010 to be "Right to Know Week" in the Province of Nova Scotia.*
